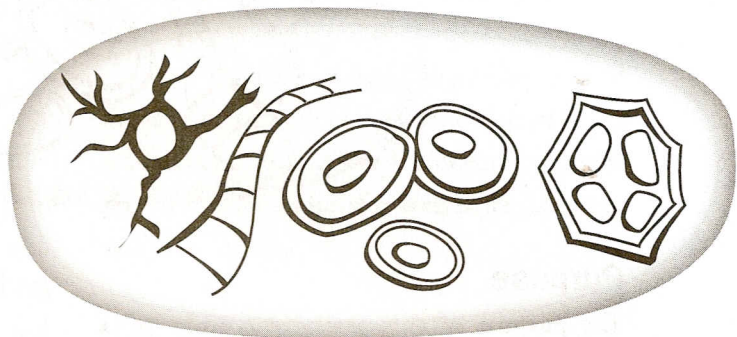


# Is It Made of Cells?
